For a class of maximum 30 children there are three activities

- 1 - Boat trip led by qualified skipper
- 2 - Museum based workshop led by experienced teacher
- 3 - Self guided canal trail with support materials

Each activity lasts approximately 45 minutes and children will take part in all activities.

The day will start with an introduction and health and safety talk at the museum.
